Shops

Skansen has various shops within the area. The shops accept creditcards and banknotes in the following currencies: Euro, US Dollar, Danish kronor and Norwegian kronor. Change is given in Swedish kronor.

Tax-Free Shopping

If you live outside the EU, you are entitled to a refund of up to 17.5% of the value-added tax that is included in the price of your purchases. Ask for a Global Refund Cheque when you shop for more than 200 Swedish kronor (SEK).

Skansenshop

The shop offers a wide range of craft products as well as first-rate modern Swedish design, clothes, books, garden tools, pottery, glass, compact discs, postcards and souvenirs. The shop is open all year round and is accessed directly from the street.

Season store

The Skansen barn at the Bollnäs square offers an assortment of practical and beautiful goods for a pleasant day at Skansen. The store is open from April to September and in December.

More shopping

There is a variety of small shops and workshops at Skansen such as bakery and glasswork.

Invoicing

Skansen sends invoices by post after your group visit is completed. The invoice includes the date of the visit, number of visitors, the entrance fee and any voucher numbers. The voucher can be sent with the invoice if so desired.
